Come to the **Health Fair** at St. Dominic on Saturday, April 30 from 10 - 3 pm. There will be screenings for diabetes and blood pressure, organ donor info, infant nutrition, self defense for kids and seniors, and a tai chi demonstration.

Kids can meet Sparky the Dog and go through the smokehouse to learn about fire safety. Speakers will give presentations on "How to Nurture Your Soul" and what to do about bed bugs.

There will be info for mental illness, raising healthy toddlers, expectant mothers, and an ask-a-nurse station. Learn about early childhood education, the Breast Cancer Fun of Ohio, taste healthy food samples, and enter the door prize drawings.
