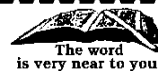

**Sunday Children's Liturgy of the Word /Preschool Programs**

Children's Sunday Liturgy of the Word class and Preschool are held during 11 a.m. Mass every Sunday except the **THIRD**Sunday in the Parish Center. Youth for Children's Liturgy, 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>grades, will leave Mass before the Readings and return to the Mass in time for the Eucharist. Preschoolers, ages 3 – 5, can be dropped off prior to Mass. Both programs teach the weekly readings heard during the Mass, with age appropriate materials. Children are in a safe, secure environment with 2 teachers and an assistant assigned to the class. **NO SIGN UP is REQUIRED** for these 2 programs.

**Most Valuable Parishioner (MVP) Is Now the Very Important Person (VIP)**

It's time to recognize the youth at St. Dominic, again! This time we're calling it the Very Important Person (VIP) program. To qualify, the youth must be a member of St. Dominic Parish and active in parish programs such as youth ministry, Parish School of Religion - PSR, Youth Choir, Lector, Altar Server, sports, or any of the other ministries. Only one youth will be recognized each month. To submit your nominee for VIP, include a written entry that includes the youth's name, age, school, and photo, his /her ministry at St. Dominic and why he/she is being nominated. The entry must be submitted by the first Monday of each month in order to process it by Youth Sunday, which is the 3<sup>rd</sup>Sunday. The selected youth will be recognized on youth Mass Sunday.
